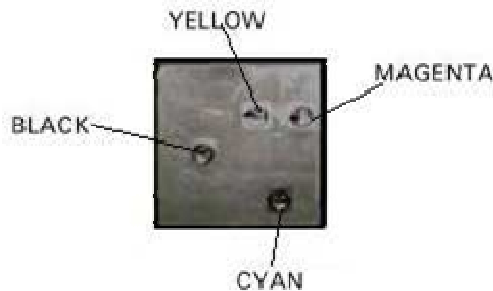


Step-by-Step Instructions

(PRINT this set of instructions, to follow every time you refill your cartridge)

CANON BC-22e Photo Cartridge

Canon BJC-2000/4200/4300/4400/4550/4650/5000



Items needed: gloves, hand-drill, small black plugs, #2 refill station, black dye, cyan, magenta, and yellow inks, paper towels, review hints & tips and check list.

Syringe: Attach needle tip (located inside station # 4) to the syringe tightly. Unscrew lid on ink bottle. Puncture silver seal with needle tip making a small hole in the center of seal. Using the correct color pull the correct amount of ink into the syringe. Rinse syringe and needle tip after every use and before using syringe with another color. Rinse syringe and needle tip with water until the water runs clear.

1. Remove plugs on top of cartridge with included small hand wrench.
2. To verify which color ink is in which chamber, insert a toothpick and check the color of the ink on the toothpick when it is withdrawn. Insert the syringe through the filling hole and push all the way into the cartridge. (Cover the other three holes with tape while filling one to prevent cross contamination)
Note: You may feel a slight pressure because the cartridge contains a sponge.
4. Slowly inject up to 10 ml. of ink, per chamber, and then replace the original plugs on the top of the cartridge. (If they're too badly damaged, don't worry. The plugs are not necessary. You only need cover the holes for extended storage or transportation to prevent leaking or drying out.)

6. Set on a paper towel for an hour as a drip precaution. Expect a few drips -- If there aren't any drips, the sponge is not saturated and ready to print.
7. Replace the cartridge and run 1 - 3 cleaning cycles as per printer instructions. [Or Print 3 pages using:](#)

For best results, let cartridge sit for 8 hours after refilling so the ink can saturate the entire sponge.

Note: Immediately refill any empty cartridges
